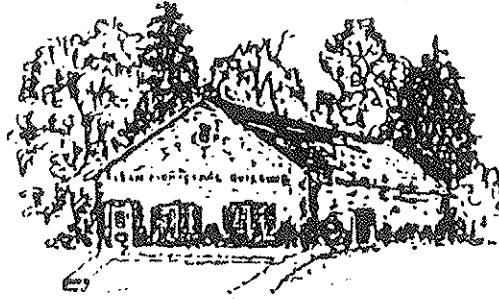

Dear Resident:

We are writing to you to provide notice that the Aldan Borough Zoning Hearing Board will hold a hearing on **Thursday, December 22, 2016 at 7:30 p.m.** at the Reinl Recreation Building, located at the end of Shisler Avenue, to consider an application submitted by the Charter School Property Development Company of Henderson, Nevada. All Aldan residents may have an interest in this zoning hearing board matter because of the potential impacts on the Borough of Aldan.

The application requests a special exception to allow the Vision Academy Charter School to operate a public charter school, including before and after school programs, at One Merion Avenue. This property is one of the buildings in the industrial park behind the Giant supermarket. It is located in the Industrial Zoning District.

The Vision Academy Charter School is an existing charter school with an enrollment of 200 students now operating in a former parochial school in Lansdowne. This applicant has not provided any specific plans or site plans to the Borough of Aldan with its application but other documents the charter school has submitted to other government agencies indicates that it desires to expand to up to 500 students. By comparison, there are about 250 students enrolled at the Aldan Elementary School.

The Aldan Borough Council intends to participate in this hearing to ensure that the interests of our residents are protected. Zoning Hearing Board meetings are open to public participation and input and we encourage you to participate.
